



Long shot, $\frac{3}{4}$ rear view of the MiG folding landing gears.




Inside cockpit. Subjective viewpoint of Capt. Tran Hanh through the canopy. US aircraft are flying at higher altitude.










Extreme close-up of the broken compass. Pan to the left. Close-up of the red part of fuel indicator.






Medium close-up profile of half of the MiG that fill in the screen. MiG banks left downwards.




